

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nursing Journal – Submission Rules

Author Guidelines

The ATSINJ is a quarterly released e-journal that publishes original research and scholarly work that contributes to the understanding and development of all aspects of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Nursing. Presentations may not only be in written form but because of the nature of the e-journal may also be audio visual or multimedia presentations.

Preferred Formats

Papers should be submitted by e-mail to submit@atsinj.com.au or through the link provided on our website in either MS-Word or Adobe PDF format.

ATSINJ prefers an A4 page with 3cm left and 4cm right margins and ARIAL font size 11 utilising 1 and a half line spacing. Papers should not exceed 4,500 words in length.

Images should be submitted in either JPEG or GIF format.

Audiovisual presentations should either be in MS-PowerPoint, AVI or MPEG2 format.

Preferred Referencing Standard

APA 5th should be utilised in the correct format throughout all submissions. Papers not adhering to this format will not be published or reviewed.

Writing Guidelines

Upon receipt of your submission you will be notified immediately via e-mail.

Your submission will then undergo blind peer review and following cross review by the Editor will be submitted into the next available edition. You will be notified via e-mail if this is the case. Please note this may take up to a period of 6 months from submission to publication. In some cases, in view of the reviewer or editors comments, the paper may need to be edited before publication. If this is the case the author will be supplied with a review commentary outlining changes to be made to your document prior to re-submission. The Editor reserves the final right to publish or decline any submissions.

Title Page

On a separate page please list the following information

Title, Author/s given name and surnames, Qualifications, Current position, Postal address, contact phone number and e-mail address. Contact details for at least one Author MUST be supplied for publication to occur.

Copyright

Any material submitted for publications must not be under consideration for, or have been published elsewhere. A copyright declaration form, completed by all authors stating that the submission has not been published elsewhere, must be attached to any submission of material for publication. Copyright **remains with the Author** and is only maintained by ATSINJ in that it is only licensed to reproduce this accepted work in any of it's web publications by your consent without further cost or reiteration to ATSINJ.
